**Quarantined**—individuals who have been separated from the rest of campus because of symptoms or exposure to COVID-19. With the test to stay program you can stay in classes (no extra curricular) if you agree to testing on day 1 day 4 and day 8 and have no symptoms. The other option is to quarantine for 5 days with no symptoms from time of exposure.

**Vaccinated:** If you are vaccinated and symptom free you do not have to quarantine. It is recommended to test 5 days after exposure to ensure you are not covid positive.

**Isolated**—individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 and are now in isolation.

**Recovered**—individuals who had tested positive for COVID-19 and have since recovered and been medically cleared.
